"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Oneal Township, about ten miles northwest of the City of Greer, lying by the North side of the Styles Mill Road, bounded by lands of the W.T.
