MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

West Gantt Baptist Church

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Citizens Lumber Company

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Nine Thousand and No/100—

DOLLARS (\$ 9000.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$90.00 on December 1, 1951, and a like payment of \$90.00 on the 1st day of each month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, located on the West side of the White Horse Road, about five miles from Greenville, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of White Horse Road (Highway 250) and running thence S. 57 W. 289 feet with the line of the property of H. C. Granger to an iron pin; thence N. 33 W. 90 feet along line of property now or formerly owned by H. T. Myers; thence N. 57-02 E. 294.6 feet along the line of the Myers property to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence along the Western side of White Horse Road, S. 29-23 E. 90 feet to the beginning, containing .62 acres, according to a survey made by John P. Cahill, Engineer, June 23, 1948. "

Said premises being the same conveyed to West Gantt Baptist Church by deed recorded in Volume 433 at Page 506.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
