To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I, -- Mamie Burton
Cheeks, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Mamie Burton Cheeks, as
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to L. E. Wood

in the full and just sum of Seventy and no/100 dollars,
to be paid six months from date,

, with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of seven per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually from ma-
turity, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Greer, being lot #1 on survey by H. S. Brockman, Jan. 4th, 1919, of
the Primus Burton Estate, and beginning at an iron pin in the road and
runs thence N 50½ E 577 feet to a stake; thence S 23 E 707 feet to a
stone; thence S 78½ W 398 feet to iron pin; thence N 43½ W 479 feet
to the beginning corner.
