the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Anna J. Odom, her heirs and assigns,

all that tract or lot of land in
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
on the South side of Otis Avenue, being known and designated as a
portion of Lot No. 1, Block "A" of the O. P. Mills property as shown
on plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book
"C", at page 179 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Otis Avenue, which point is
213 feet West of the intersection of Augusta Street and Otis Avenue and
running thence along the South side of Otis Avenue, South 71-35 West 60
feet to an iron pin; thence South 18-05 East 151.3 feet to an iron pin;
thence North 63-33 East 60.8 feet to an iron pin; thence North 18-00'
West 143.1 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Otis Avenue, the be-
