All that parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon in Chack Springs Township, of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the Norwest side of the U.S. Dual Lame Highway No. 29, about onehalf mile West from Taylors, in 9-B School District, bounded on North and East by lands now or formerly owned by R.R. Martin, on the Southeast by said highway, and on other sides by lands of Shelton J. Rimer, having the following courses and distances, to wit: REGINNING on an iron pin on edge of said highway, joint corner with property now or formerly owned by R.R. Martin, and runs thence N. 38.13 W. 285 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence a new line S. 51.47 W. 132 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence another new line S. 39.00 E. 285 feat to an iron pin on edge of said U.S. Highway No. 29; thence therewith N. 51.47 E. to the beginning worner, containing 86/100 of an acre, more or less, and being a portion of that property conveyed to me by W.M.
