thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 23 of the property of Lee Roy Styles according to a plat thereof prepared by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, September, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at page 63, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Walnut Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 86-45 W. 279 feet to Pole Branch; thence up the meanders of said branch, in a northeasterly direction, 176 feet, more or less, to a point on the south side of Walnut Lane; thence along the south side of Walnut Lane, N. 86-45 E. 169.8 feet to an iron pin; thence following a bend of Walnut Lane, S. 48-15 E. 42-4 feet to an iron pin on the south side of said Walnut Lane; thence along the south side of said Walnut Lane, S. 3-15 E. 130 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Roy Styles by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
