"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, School District 160, formerly 6-E, and being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of a revised plat of the property of W. R. Cordell made by Dalton and Neves in March, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Z, at page 44, said lot being a portion of a re-subdivision of Lot No. 129 of Map 4 of a subdivision known as Camilla Park as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 117, and having, accord ing to the Dalton revised plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of a 100-foot width easement of the Duke Power Company for transmission line at the corner of Lot No. 2, which point is 150 feet south of the old Easley Bridge Road, and running thence along the rear line of Lots 2 and 1, N. 87-51 E. 159.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 1 of the Cordell plat; thence S. 21-00 E. 74 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 7 of the Cordell plat; thence S. 87-51 W. 183.3 feet to an iron pin on the east side of the transmission line of the Duke Power Company; thence along the line of said transmission line right-of-way, which is now used as a road, N. 2-09 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
