(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Three Thousand and No/100- - - - -** DOLLARS (\$ 3000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, and known and designated as lot No. 11, Block F, according to plat of property of Chapin Springs Land Company, recorded in Plat Book E at Page 41, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of Rose Avenue, joint front corner of lots Nos. 11 and 12, thence with the line of said lots, N. 2-0 W. 150 feet to a stake; thence with the rear line of lots Nos. 9 and 10, N. 88-0 E. 84.7 feet to a stake; thence with the line of property now or formerly of McDaniel, S. 10-44 W. 153.9 feet to a stake; thence with the Northern side of said Avenue, S. 88-0 W. 51.2 feet to the beginning corner."
