NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand/well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

J. Riddle, in August 1945, and described as follows:

*BECINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Dunham Bridge Road, corner of property now or Termerly camed by Charles W. White, and BonnieD. White, and running thence along the line of said property, S. 45-30 E. 453.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15-36 E. 76.9 feet to corner of property now or formerly owned by T. C.
