KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That us the said Woodrow B. Painter and foresaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Citizens Building & Loan Association, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagor. In hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenwille, near the City of Green (now in the new City Limits of Green), on the Northern side of Maryland Avenue in a sub-division known as Development No. 2, Victor-Monaghan Co., Division of J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., and being described according to a plat of the aforementioned sub-division prepared by Dalton & Neves Engineers, dated April 1947, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "P" at page 119. The property herein conveyed has, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit: and is lot No. 56 of the aforementioned sub-division:

EEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Maryland Avenue at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 55 and 56 and running thence along the common line of said lots N. 35-21 E. 170 feet to a point on the Southern side of a ten foot alley; thence along the southern side of said alley N. 54-39 W. 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots S. 35-21 W. 170 feet to a point on the northern side of Maryland Avenue; thence along the northern side of Maryland Avenue S. 54-39 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of the same lot of land with improvements thereon conveyed to Collett R.
