WHEREAS I, C. Otto White, Jr.

am well and truly indebted to

South Carolina National Bank as trustee under the will of James P. Gossett in the full and just sum of - - - Four Thousand and No/100 (\$4000.00) - - - - Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable \$500.00 each six months after date, payments to be applied first to interest, balance to principal,

with interest from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said C. Otto White, Jr.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina National Bank as trustee under the will of James P. Gossett, its successors and assigns forever:

All those pieces, parcels and lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina lying and being in the City of Greenville on the Southern side of East Faris Road and being known and described as a portion of Lots No. 9, 10, 11 & 12 as shown on a plat by R. E. Dalton dated October, 1922, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, Plat Book F, Page 141 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of East Faris Road which iron pin is N. 62-51 E., 211 feet from the original Southeast intersection of Augusta Road and Blassingame Street (now East Faris Road) and running thence along East Faris Road W. 62-51 E., 68 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 10 and 9; thence along said line S. 26-30 E., 150.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 63-03 E., 60 feet to an iron pin on line between lots 9 & 8; thence along said line S. 26-30 E., 49 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 9 & 8 and property of Davenport estate; thence S. 63-03 W., 60 feet to an iron pin corner of lots 9 & 10; thence N. 57-55 W., 115.3 feet to an iron pin at corner of Pickell and on line between lots 10 & 12; thence along said line N. 26-30 W., 20 feet to an iron pin, which corner is 80.9 feet from East Faris Road; thence S. 73-30 W., 7.2 feet along line between Pickell and property of the City of Greenville to an iron pin; thence N. 27-09 N., 79.2 feet to the beginning corner on East Faris Road.

The above described property is the same conveyed to me by the City of Greenville by Deed dated December 5, 1950 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office Deed Book 434, Page 372.
