Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of TWELVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 - - - - - - Dollars (\$12,000.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of Dollars (\$ 12,000.00) with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 4 3/4 per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the lst day of June 19 52 and thereafter said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the <u>lst</u> day of\_\_\_\_\_day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 93.34 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the lst day of May , 1967, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the lst day of June 1967; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 93.34 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of 4 3/4 per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$12,000 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. C. in Plat Book "Z", Page 170, and having, according to said plats, and a recent survey made by A. C. Crouch, May 9, 1952, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of East Fairview Avenue, said pin being 358.3 feet in an Easterly direction from the Northeast corner of the intersection of East Fairview Avenue and Bennett Street, and running thence, N. 23-23 E. 236.8 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence down the center of the branch (the traverse line being N. 82-56 E. 82.4 feet) to a point in the center of said branch on the Southwest side of Old Chick Springs Road; thence with the Southwest side of Old Chick Springs Road, S. 29-20 E. 34.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-06 W. 278.9 feet to an iron pin on the North side of East Fairview Avenue; thence with the North side of East Fairview Avenue, N. 48-22 W. 91.9 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the North side of East Fairview Avenue, N. 65-42 W.
