DOLLARS, to be paid as follows: \$261.00 each and every month hereafter until interes and principal are paid in full, with the privilege of paying additional sums at any time, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 4½ per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the Northeast side of State Highway No. 14 (formerly Buncombe Road), on the opposite side of said Highway from Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, about two miles Southwest from Greer, in Chick Springs Township, , containing 1.9 acres, more or less, and being a part of Tract No. 2 on a Plat of the property of J.G. Greer, L.B. Vaughn, I.M. Wood and J.A. Wood, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of said highway, corner of Lot No. 4 of the J.A.
