Hunter; thence N. 55-18 W. 117.3 feet to an iron pin on a 15-foot driveway; thence along said driveway, S. 27-26 W. 206.4 feet to an iron pin on Franklin Road; thence with said Franklin Road 5. 64-26 E. 99.4 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
