Raymond Williams, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and imprevements thereon, in Grove Township, County and State aforesaid, about eight (8) miles Southwest of Greenville, South Carolina, being Tract No. 2 of the property of G. C. Richardson, according to plat made by W. J. Riddle, containing 58.80 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake in bf nch, corner of Tract No. 1 and running thence Southerly with said branch for a part of the distance to a stone; thence contimuing Southerly a total distance of 1056 feet to a stone, corner of Tarrant's land; thence N. 49-10 E. 1894 feet to an iron pin at Norris' corner; thence N. 46 W. 1952 feet to corner of Norris' line; thence S. 23-40 W. 1398 feet to the beginning corner.
