NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said W. K. Evans and Radford F. Evans

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, as trustee under agreement with Victor L. Cannon,

on Piedmont-Bessie Road and having the following metes and bounds,

BEGINNING at an I. P. on highway, thence 200 feet to corner of tract now or formerly owned by Charles Edward Mitchell, thence N 23-40 E. 915 Feet to pin at the corner of land owned by J. A. Blakely, thence along Blakely line S 89 209.5 feet to a stake, thence S 66-0 W 1069 Feet to beginning corner on highway. The tract contains 4.33 acres, and according to survey made by W. J. Riddle on September 1945, this tract is known as lot #3 on said blueprint.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Two and Seventy one-hundreth (2.70) acres more or less, and being one-half of Tract #2 of Surveyor, September 1945, and being more particularly described as follows:
