ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Southwesterly side of Trowbridge Avenue on Paris Mountain, near the City of Greenville, S. C., containing 3.55 acres, as shown on the plat of the property of J. Robert Thomason made by Dalton & Neves, dated May, 1951 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "X", page 86, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Mills, Jr. property; thence with the line of the Mills property S 23-0 W 279 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of the Mills property S 37-45 W 46.3 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with the Mills and Stephenson property; thence along the joint line with the Stephenson property the following courses and distances: S 35-54 E 407.8 feet to an iron pin, S 75-52 E 191 feet to an iron pin, and N 5-18 E 330 feet to the point of beginning.
