TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Grady Webb,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twelve Hundred

DOLLARS (\$ 1,200.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%)

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oneal

Township, lying on the East side of the Groce Meadow Road, on branch waters of South Tyger River, bounded by lands of Roy Collins, Hoyt and Earl Dill, R.P. Howell Estate, and possibly others, containing 22.05 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on an iron pin or stone by pine on southwest corner of the tract, corner with Roy Collins and Howell Estate, and runs thence with the Collins line N. 75.15 E. 7.44 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 14.45 E. 0.18 links to an iron pin, new corner; thence with a farm road N. 76.09 E. 9.09 chains to an iron pin on northern side of road; thence S. 67.15 E. 2.56 chains to an iron pin on the northern side of said road; thence N. 86.20 E. 3.85 chains to an iron pin about 25 feet north of barn; thence S. 67.00 E. to a stone and iron pin, joint corner of Hoyt Dill tract; thence S. 64.00 W. 24.97 chains to a stake on the Howell line; thence with the Howell line N. 35.00 W. 12.88 chains to the beginning corner, and being all of that tract of land conveyed to me by M.L. Lanford by deed dated January 15, 1947, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 306, at page 96.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
