All that piece or parcel or land lying and being in the above State and County, Grove Township, containing eight acres, more or less, and being the same land as conveyed to my father, Frank L. Rogers by J. G. Mock and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. of the above county in Vol. LLL page 315 and more fully described in said deed.

Also, all of that part or parcel of the land of the Alice C. Charles land situated on the east side of the old Augusta Road (the part of the said Charles land on the west side of the old Augusta Road having been deeded by Frank L. Rogers to Willie Hall by deed dated January 31, 1939) Thus making the old Augusta Road the line between Willie Hall and the grantor herein.
