all that tract or lot of land in Bates ----- Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles North from Travelers Rest, lying West from Highway No. 276 (U.S. Highway) and on the East side of a new street, being all of Lot No. 33 on a plat of property made for Nannie K. Hunt Estate, Subdivision plat by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated November 15 and 16, 1951, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following courses and distances:
