WHEREAS, I the said R. G. Pace

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

Pace in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE. at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, and being a portion of 21.28 acres of land on the southwest side of the Parker Road, and being shown as an unnumbered lot on No. 2 Preliminary plat of R.
