C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagor. In hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. BEGINNING at iron pin in the center of Few's Bridge Road, and runs thence North 0-45 W. 257 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 25-30 E. 175 feet to a stake in field; thence S. 34-45 W. 119 feet to iron pin in above stated Road, the beginning corner; and containing two-tenths (2/10)of one acre, more or less, being the same piece and lot of land conveyed to us by Deed by Fannie G. BEGINNING at iron pin in the center of Few's Bridge Road, and runs thence N. 36-45 E. 176 feet to iron pin; thence S. 0-45 E. 257 feet to iron pin in above stated Road; thence with the center of said Road as the line N. 42-30 W. 158 feet to the beginning; being part of the same conveyed to W. King Bramlett by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated September 12, 1947, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 317, page 189; also being the same tract and lot of land conveyed to us by Deed by W. King Bramlett, dated August 24, 1949, and recorded in office of R. M. C., County aforesaid, in Deed Book 390, page 376.
