with interest thereon from date at the rate of _____ per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **on or before April 29, 1953**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Ashford Avenue, 275 feet North from Wellington Avenue, at corner of lot 89, and running thence with line of said lot, S. 70-41 E. 164.2 feet to a stake in line of lot 17; thence with line of lot 17, N. 19-02 E. 59.8 feet to a stake at corner of lot 16; thence continuing with line of lot 16, N. 18-37 E. 90 feet to a stake at corner of lot 92; thence with line of said lot, N. 70-37 W. 162 feet to a stake on Ashford Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Ashford Avenue, S. 19-32 W. 150 feet to the point of beginning."
