Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty and ninety-two one-hundreths Dollars (\$40.92), commencing on the thirteenth day of March , 19 53, and continuing on the thirteenth day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the thirteenth day of February , 19. 73.
