To All Whom These Presents May Concern

Milton Trotter

hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagor send greeting.

Whereas Milton Trotter

is justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100 - - - - - Dollars

(\$8,900.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$8,900.00)

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of four per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the

1st day of March 1953, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the sum of \$46.98 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of January, 1978, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the 1st day of February, 1978, the aforesaid monthly payments of \$46.98 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate

of four per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$8,900.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns, forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the west side of LeGrand Boulevard, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 72 on plat of Snerwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "BB", at Pages 30 and 31, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of LeGrand Boulevard, at joint front corner of Lots 72 and 73 and running thence with the line of Lot 73, S. 88-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-30 W. 74 feet to an iron on the south side of Don Drive; thence with the south side of Don Drive, N. 61-27 E. 66.9 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Don Drive, N. 69-22 E. 44.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Don Drive and LeGrand Boulevard, (the chord being S. 61-30 E. 39.2 feet) to an iron pin on the west side of LeGrand Boulevard; thence with the west side of LeGrand Boulevard, S. 12-23 E. 44.8 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the west side of LeGrand Boulevard, S. 6-35 E. 55.2 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of John T. Douglas and T. Frank Huguenin, of even date and to be recorded herewith.

Also, one Kresky Oil Floor Furnace with 275 gallon fuel tank, one 30 gallon electric water heater, one disappearing stairway and one car port located in the dwelling on the lot above described, which is acknowledged to be a part of the mortgaged premises hereinabove described.
