, with interest thereon from date quarterly

at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, as above,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

BEGINNING at corner of that lot of land conveyed by Gilreath to Beavers in 1918 (Vol. 14 at page 212), and running thence with said David Street, N. 23 W. 43 1/3 feet to point, corner of Gilreath lot, same conveyed to Murphree; thence S. 66 W. 180 feet along line of said last mentioned lot, to point; thence in a line parallel with David Street S. 23 E. 43 1/3 feet to point, corner of said Beavers lot; and thence N. 66 E. 180 feet along the line of said Beavers lot to the point of beginning on David Street.
