To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I,-- **William C. Stokes,** SEND GREETING:

Whereas, **I**, the said **William C. Stokes,**

in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these Presents, **am** well and truly indebted to **E H Edwards**

in the full and just sum of **Two thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00) d o l l a r s -**
to be paid **one year from date hereof,**

with interest thereon from **date hereof**

at the rate of **seven** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **annually in advance,**

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **E H Edwards**

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to **me**, the said **mortgagor**

, in hand well and truly paid by the said **mortgagee**

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **E. H. Edwards, his heirs and assigns:-**

That certain lot or parcel of land, with the improvements thereon, near **Lenoah Public School, Highland Township, said County and State,** on the south side of the surfaced road leading from said School by Camp Creek to Tigerville, being all of tracts Nos.15 and 16 on plat of the W. W. Davis Estate, by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, January 23, 1947, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on a poplar on Jenkins' line southeastern corner of Tract #16; thence N 25-45 E four hundred eighty-five (485) feet to a stake on the south edge of said road; thence therewith six hundred (600) feet to a stake, corner Tract #14; thence with line of Nos.14 and 15 tracts, S
