All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in City of Greenville, on southwestern corner of Gower Street and Lindbergh Avenue, being the northeastern or front portion of that certain lot known and designated as Lot Number Twenty One (No. 21) of the L. A. Mills subdivision, as represented by a plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs. January, 1928, recorded in Plat Book "H" at page 117-118 in R.M.C. office for Greenville County, and according to said plat, in part, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
