Dixon , in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING & LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagors in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the Northern side of Virginia Avenue near the Town of Greer (now in the new City Limits of Greer), and being known and designated as Lot No. 28 on plat of Development No. 2, Victor-Monaghan Company, Division of J. P. Stevens & Company, Inc. Greer Plant, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1947, and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "P" at page 119, and having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Virginia Avenue at the joint front corner of lots No. 28 and 29, and runs thence slong the commonline of said lots, N. 35.21 E. 170 feet to the edge of a 10-foot alley reserved for utilities; thence along said alley, S. 54.39 E. 105 feet to a point on the edge of said alley, at the joint rear corner of lots No. 27 and 28; thence along the common line of said lots S. 35.21 W. 170 feet to a point on the Northern side of Virginia Avenue; thence along Virginia Avenue, N. 54.39 W. 105 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of the same lot of land conveyed to Jehn T.
