TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Everett Nicholson,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, in the Town of Travelers Rest, being shown as all of Lots Nos. 30, 31, 55, 56 and a 35-foot strip taken from the Southern portion of Lot No. 70-A as shown on a revised plat of the "Love Estates", made by W. J. Riddle in February, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at Page 31 and, when described as a whole, have the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 29 of the said
"Love Estates" on the road leading from the Buncombe Road into the business
section of Travelers Rest, and running thence along said road, N. 64 E. 200 feet
