"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southwest side of a County Road leading to Greenville, about seven miles southeast of the Greenville County Courthouse, being shown as a portion of Tract 3 on plat of property of G. S. Hamby Estate, made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, December 30, 1915 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of a County Road leading to Greenville, said pin being 360 feet northwest of a point in the center of a County Road lying between the property of Mary H. Butler and Wealthy H. Green, and running thence along the road to Greenville, N. 65-1/2 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence turn ing at a right angle and running in a southwesterly direction 210 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 65-1/2 E. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence again turning at a right angle and running in a northeasterly direction 210 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of the road leading to Greenville, the beginning corner, and contains one acre, more or less; being the same conveyed to me by Mary H. Butler by deed dated March 21, 195 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 475, at page 20."
