Vaughn, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING & LOAN ASSOCIATION, Dollars to the said mortgagor—in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oaklawn Township, being originally a part of the I. P. Jerdan, Estate. The lot lies on the East side of the Cooley Bridge Road to Belton, and has the following courses and distances according to a survey and plat made by C. O. Riddle, February 25, 1953, to wit:-

EEGINNING at a point in center of Cooley Bridge Read, joint corner of Lot #12 of the I. P. Jordan land, thence S. 77-36 E. 430 feet to iron pin on Jordan line; thence S. 1-42 E. 209 feet to iron pin; thence N. 77-36 W. 430 feet to point in center of said road; thence along center of road in a mortherly direction 209 feet to beginning corner, bounded on the North by Tract #12 of the Jordan land, on the East and South by other land of Sadie Fowler; on the West by Cooley Bridge Read.
