All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 6 miles from the City of Greenville on the Old White Horse Road containing 5/100 of an acre, being part of the old Thompson land and having the following metes and bounds according to Plat and survey by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, May 3, 1948:

BEGINNING at iron pin in center of Old White Horse Road, corner J. B.
