"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 6-E, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of the property of Mrs. Bertie E. Burns as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at page 30, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Bent Bridge Road (now known as Harrison avenue), at a point approximately 247 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and said Bent Bridge Road, which point is the center of a strip left for a roadway which was never opened, and running thence along the center of said proposed roadway, N. 22-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-50 W. 62 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the joint line of said Lots Nos. 1 and 2, S. 22-17 E. 150 feet to the joint corner of said lots on the north side of Bent Bridge Road; thence along the line of said Bent Bridge Road, S. 81-50 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
