August 30, 1947, recorded in Deed Book 319, Page 158. By a deed of even date herewith the said Mae Cox under the name of Mae Cox Prohazka conveyed her one-fourth (1/4) interest in what remained of the two acre parcel of land unto Florence B. Cox thereby giving title to all of what remains of the two acre parcel of land to Florence B. Cox and Nancy Ann Cox Barnett with the said Florence B.
