MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE COUNTY OF Greenville To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I, Rev. O. J. Morgan, of Greenville County. SEND GREETINGS: WHEREAS, I the said Rev. O. J. Morgan in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Eighty and No/100 - - - - - - - - (\$ 80.00 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear. NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Rev. O. J. Morgan in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, Rev. O. J. Morgan in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the south side of Perry Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 43 of the property of H. J. Haynsworth and Davis Furman, being a subdivision of the Speegle land, and being more particularly described as follows: "BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Perry Avenue at a point approximately 279.3 feet east of the intersection of Irvine Street, and running thence in a southwesterly direction 178 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the north side of a 13-foot alley; thence along the line of said alley in an easterly direction 50 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 42; thence along the line of that lot in a northeasterly direction 181 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the south side of Perry Avenue; thence along the south side of said
