"All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on Birnie Street, adjoining lot now or formerly of Catherine Kuykendall, fronting Birnie Street 48 feet, and running back in parallel lines a distance of 110 feet, more or less.

The above lot of land was formerly owned by the late M. M. Kuykendall and at the time of his death was inherited by his wife, Catherine Kuykendall, and their three sons, Alfred, Lewis and Albert Kuykendall. By deed dated February 9, 1926, recorded in R.M.C.
