with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$50.00 on November 14, 1953, and a like payment of \$50.00 on the 14th day of each month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, IN BATES TOWNSHIP, on or near the Pleasant View Welcome Road, which road is approximately one-helf mile north of the White Horse Road, and having according to a plat of W. A. Hester dated November 30, 1940, the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINING at a stone on the bank of the Pleasant View Welcome Road, and running thence across said road, N. 15 W. 11 chains to poplar X3; thence N. $85\frac{1}{2}$ W. 17.04 chains to a pine X3NM; thence N. 46 W. 11.37 chains to iron pin; thence N. 88 W. 3.11 chains to iron pin; thence S. 5 E. 6.11 chains to a small P.O.
