All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in O'Neal Township, located about two miles southeast from Mountain View School, on the south side of Few's Bridge Road as shown on a plat thereof made on October 16, 1953 by H. S. Brockman, Reg. Surveyor, composed of three lots of land, and having in the aggregate, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and stopper in the center of Few's Bridge Road at the corner of property of J. A.
