"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, near Oneal, lying on the southeast side of the road that leads from Oneal to Berry's Mill, being bounded on the north and east by other lands of Jessie J.
