All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville and being shown and designated on the Greenville City Black Book as Lot Number One Hundred and Two (102) of Block I on sheet 10; said lot of land being described according to said City Block Book as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the Eastern side of Parker (Viola) Street at the corner of a lot of land formerly owned by T. W.
