be computed and paid monthly

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 87 and a portion of lot 88, as shown on Map # 2, of Micholtown Heights, recorded in Plat Book M at Pages 4 and 5, and being more part cularly described according to a revised plat of lots87, 88 and 89, Man # 2 of Nicholtown Heights, prepared by C. O. Riddle, November 5, 1953, as follows:
