all that tract or lot of land in Town of Simpsonville, Remarks, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and joining lands of T. R. Cox, Mrs. L. O. Green, R. D. Jones and Main Street in Simpsonville, same being on the western side of Main Street, and known as the Three Story Brick Building formerly occupied by Brown & Armstrong, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on Main Street corner of T. R. Cox lot and running in a western direction 100 ft. to Mrs. L. O. Green's line; thence North 27 feet to R. D. Jones other lot, and thence East 100 feet to Main Street and thence along said street 27 feet to the beginning corner. Also, subject to the agreement between T. R. Cox and R. D.
