"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 32 and 33 of the property known as Nicholtown Heights, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 4 as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwestern intersection of Mims Avenue and Watson Street, and running thence along Mims Avenue, N. 0-45 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 33 and 34; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 89-15 W 110 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 6; thence along the rear lines of Lots 6 and 7, S. 0-45 E. 80 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Watson Street; thence along Watson Street, N. 89-15 E. 110 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
