"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, known and designated as lot #57, and the Southern 12½ feet of lot #58, of Lanneau Drive Highlands, according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1937, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "D" at Pages 288-289, and having the following metes and bounds:
