C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, about two miles mortheast from the City of Greer, in the County of Greenville, lying on the South side of the old CCC Camp Road and on the West side of the Miller Bridge Road, known and designated as lots nos. 7 and 8 on a plat of property made for B. H. Burnett by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, dated February 6, 1950, recorded in theR. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book T, page 244, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a stake on the southern edge of the old CCC Camp Road and in the bend of said road, the northeastern corner of lot No. 7, and runs thence with the western edge of Miller Bridge Road S. 56.34 E. 139.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 33.63 W. 147 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 8 and 9; thencewith the common line of lots 8 and 9 N. 62.24 W. 202 feet to a stake on the edge of the CCC Camp Road; thence therewith N. 38 E. 70 feet to stake; thence N 63.24 E. 112 feet to the beginning corner.
