H. Mauldin dated January 19, 1954 by C. C. Jones. From the later plat the following description is taken, the two lots beindescribed together:
"BEGINNING at the southeast intersection of Fairview Avenue and Wautauga Strand running thence the eastern edge of Wautauga Street, S. 23-30 W. 142 feet to a corner; thence S. 49-30 W. 29 feet to a corner; thence S. 21-22 E. 34.5 feet to a corner and continuing the same bearing 136 feet to a corner in the line of Floyd property; thence running a joint line with that property, N. 23-30 E. 157 feet to a corner on the southern side of Fairview Avenue; thence running the southern side of this avenue along a curve the chord of which runs N. 16-53 W. 80 feet to a corner; thence the southern side of said avenue, N. 34-34 W. 55 feet to a corner and centinuing N. 40-27 W. 54.6 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
