NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

TRACT #1: All that tract or parcel of land about one mile from Jonesville, in Union County, State of South Carolina, located on the West side of Bishop Road, also known as the Meansville Road, containing Forty Seven and Three Tenths (17.3) acres, more or less, and being described as follows: BEGINNING at an old iron pin in the Bishop Road, corner of property formerly owned by Emma Boyd, and running with said line North 81 degrees 30 minutes West 381 feet to a stone; thence South 16 degrees West 358 feet to an iron pin; thence North 61 degrees 05 minutes West 832 feet to old iron pin; thence North 59 degrees 43 minutes West 616 feet to small white Flint; thence North 29 degrees 28 minutes East 1026 feet to an old stone, corner with H. H. Sprouse by W. N. Willis, Engineers, dated May 4, 1951, and recorded in Plat Book 29, Page 336, R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County, and being more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a stone at corner of property now or formerly owned by Weathers, and running thence South 45 minutes West 1418 feet to a stone near branch; thence North 52 degrees 25 minutes West 1592 feet to a stone at corner of property now or formerly owned by Chris Brown; thence North 38 degrees 35 minutes East 1000 feet to a stone; thence South 65 degrees 43 minutes East 1808 feet to a stone, the beginning, being the same property conveyed to Ralph Phillips and Alice L.
