Riddle, surveyor, July 14, 1944, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of the Paris Mountain road at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to D.B. Tripp, which point is 129.4 feet west from the corner of the Cole property, and running thence with the line of the property now or formerly belonging to D.B.
