"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, lying between White Horse Road and Keeler Bridge Road, and containing 2 acres, more or less, and having, according to a survey prepared for Edith P. Carter by J. C. Hill, L. S., July 6, 1954, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Keeler Bridge Road at the corner of Hester property, and running thence with the Hester property, N. 82-30 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the line of said Hester property, N. 62-00 E. 249.5 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of White Horse Road; thence with White Horse Road, S. 31-00 E. 190 feet to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with the northern line of Poole property, S. 59-00 W. 333.1 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Keeler Bridge Road; thence with Keeler Bridge Road, N. 56-15 W. 376.1 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty."
